Corrigendum

Part II, page 46, in the column of "Main Achievements", the second paragraph should be replaced with the following paragraph:

Emergency response: UNEP, together with OCHA, conducted 14 activities (70% of the target) to prevent, reduce the risk of, prepare for or respond to environmental emergencies. These consisted of emergency response missions to developing countries and countries with economies in transition, including Côte d'Ivoire, Honduras, Indonesia, Lebanon, Madagascar, Peru, the Philippines, Republic of Korea, Serbia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Ukraine and Uruguay. An emergency response mission was also sent to the occupied Palestinian territories. The mission teams conducted rapid environmental assessments and provided technical advice. In each case, the environmental risks were mitigated by national authorities and international partners based on the advice received.
